Policies for Short-Term Mission Trips

Field Behavior

1. Volunteers are reminded that they are ambassadors of the Lord Jesus Christ. As volunteers, they not only represent Him, but the United States, FBC Loganville, and our International Mission Board. This responsibility is tremendous; consequently, it is our responsibility to prayerfully select the volunteer that we believe is best suited for the particular missions endeavor.
2. Volunteers must submit to the Team Leader's authority.
3. Due to the political instability and anti-American sentiment often present in various countries around the world, FBC asks each volunteer to refrain from expressing personal political opinions while on the field.
4. Volunteers must abstain from the use of alcoholic beverages or tobacco products in any form during the entire duration of the trip.
5. If, at any time while on the field, a volunteer's behavior constitutes a problem, the team leader has the authority to ask the volunteer to return home. Any additional cost incurred as a result of this action will be at that volunteer's expense.

Other Expectations/Requirements

1. Team members must attend training sessions scheduled by the team leader. Team training sessions are vital to the success of the mission trip. Team leaders are committed to scheduling enough sessions to ensure the success of the trip.
2. Spiritual preparation is vital to the accomplishment of the Lord's work. Team members must commit to a daily devotional life and to specific preparation for the trip. The Lord will use this opportunity to allow you to impact the lives of others for His Kingdom. As you probably know, the Lord will also use this journey to forever change your view of His work in the world. Prayer now, throughout the preparation time, and during the journey is essential. Anything done of spiritual significance will be the work of the Holy Spirit, in a vessel (you) readily available to do His bidding. Team leaders are committed to spiritual preparation and growth as the most important task of their team.
3. Other expectations are shared at team meetings for a particular trip.
4. **Please Note:** If a mission team member has not raised the sufficient amount of money to purchase a plane ticket by the pre-determined deadline to purchase such tickets, the applicant will forfeit their spot on the team and all personal monies and deposits will either be refunded to the applicant or put towards a mission trip.
5. Please include a \$200.00 deposit check along with two personal reference forms long with this completed application.
